

Examples from recent RFPs/NOFOs/FOAs

<u>Tennessee Department of Human Services Implementation</u> <u>Grant for TANF Families - 2022</u>

Describe the Collaborative's plan to continue its work after funding ends and how it will continue to expand the continuum of care for low-income families throughout the geographic area of focus. Describe how other funding sources will be leveraged to support this work beyond the funding period.



<u>The Georgia Governor's Office of Highway Safety "Innovative</u> <u>Grants" Request for Proposals</u>

For detailed information in completing the referenced program guidelines, applicants must complete each section in eGOHS Plus. All proposals must include the following information:

Self Sufficiency: This statement must reflect a plan of action that explains how the activities of the project will be continued after federal funds are no longer available to implement this project. The self-sufficiency plan must identify potential sources of non-federal funds.

P3s are contractual agreements between a public agency and a private entity that allow for greater private participation in the delivery of projects.
