CITY OF CONYERS ARPA GRANTS



For Residents & Businesses

Residential Assistance

- On December 15, 2021, the Mayor and City Council authorized the City to provide up to 250 City residents with \$1,000 in residential assistance awards using funds the City received as part of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, known as ARPA.
- To be eligible, a City resident must meet all the established residency, income and hardship requirements.
- Awards are limited to one (1) per household, based upon residential street address.

- Awards are first come, first serve.
- Certain individual are not eligible. They include:
 - 1. Individuals who work for a local, state, and federal government (including school boards).
 - 2. Elected officials.
 - 3. Immediate family members of a City of Conyers or Rockdale County employee who lives resides with the employee (Immediate family member is defined as being a: spouse or domestic partner, child, step-child, parent, step-parent, sibling, step-sibling, grandparent or grandchild).
 - 4. Individuals who have received any ARPA funds from Rockdale County, Georgia.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Residency Requirement: An individual must:
 - 1. Currently live within the city limits of the City of Conyers; AND
 - 2.Be a resident since May 1, 2021
- Income Requirement: Adjusted gross household income (AGI) of \$50,000 or less when considering household income and number of dependents.
- Hardship Requirement: An individual must have experienced a hardship due the corona virus pandemic.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

Proof of Residency

- A copy of a current signed lease agreement or a copy of a current mortgage statement or property tax receipt.*
- Plus one of the following:
 - 1. Automobile registration with the same address; **OR**
 - 2. Current gas, electricity or water bill with the same address.

*Exception for residence who lost housing and was forced to live in a hotel or motel: Six (6) months of hotel/motel payment receipts for the dates of May 1, 2021 to November 1, 2021 may be presented

Proof of Income

- A copy of the individual's Federal Tax Return (1040) for tax year past 2 years.
 - 1. Copies of 2019, 2020 and/or 2021 are acceptable.
 - 2. Individual must submit pages 1 & 2 of the form 1040

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

Proof of Hardship

• A copy of unemployment benefits at anytime from March 1, 2020 to November 1, 2021 **OR** a copy of past due bill on a utility** or housing payment on at least two (2) occasions between March 1, 2020 to November 1, 2021.

Other Required Documents

• A copy of a valid picture ID.

^{**}For this program, utility will be defined as electric, gas, water, cable or telephone.

APPLICATIONS

- Residence were instructed to submit their applications online via the city's website.
- Residence needing assistance are instructed to come to City Hall for assistance in their application.



APPLICATION PROCESS

- We created an online application using SeamlessDocs by GovOS
 - 1. https://conyers.seamlessdocs.com/f/resident_ARPA
 - 2. There are many other platforms such as Formsite, SignNow, DocuSign, etc. that can be used.
- We created an "in-house" ARPA special project team.

Business Assistance

- On December 15, 2021, the Mayor and City Council authorized the City to provide up to **50** City residents with **\$5,000** in business assistance awards using funds the City received as part of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, known as ARPA.
- To be eligible, a City business must meet several requirements under this program.

- Awards are first come, first serve.
- Certain individual are not eligible. They include:
 - 1. Business owners who work for a local, state, and federal government (including school boards).
 - 2. Owned by an elected officials.
 - 3. Business who received any COVID-19 related relief funds, such as PPP, EDIL or American Rescue Plan Act ("ARPA") funds from any other entity, including Rockdale County, Georgia.
 - 4. Non-profit organizations.

ELIGIBLITY REQUIRMENTS

General Requirement:

- Must be a current City business owner for at least the previous 2 years, as of November 1, 2021
- Must have less than 25 employees

• Specific Requirements:

• Must have a revenue loss of at least 35% since March 1, 2020

DOCUMENT REQUIREMENTS

- Provide a valid picture ID with application
- Provided a completed W-9
- Copies of business license from 2019, 2020, and 2021
- Copies of 2019 & 2020 W-3 or Form 1096 to prove less than 25 employees or subcontractors
- Annual Profit and Loss (P&L) statement for 2019 & 2020
- Copies of 2019 & 2020 business tax return
 - 1040 Individual Income Tax Return with a Schedule C Profit or Loss from Business
 - 1120 US Corporation Income Tax Return
 - 1120-S US Income Tax Return for an S Corporation
- Copy of IRS transcripts for 2019 & 2020

APPLICATION PROCESS


Business application must be submitted online via the City's website

- The flow chart process is very similar to the resident flowchart.


THINGS TO THINK ABOUT

REJECTED RESIDENT APPLICATIONS

- The majority of rejected applications are for those who do not live in the city limits.
- People don't understand that just because their mailing address is "Conyers, GA" it doesn't mean they live in the city limits.
- If you are a city, be prepared to explain and educate those applicants.




RESIDENTS WHO DON'T FILE A TAX RETURN



- Not everyone has to file a tax return, and whether you need to file depends on your age, filing status, income level, and the source of that income.
- If the resident is not required to file a tax return, simply get signed letter from the applicant stating he/she is not required to file a tax return.

BUSINESSES WITH NO EMPLOYEES OR SUBCONTRACTORS



 If a business applicant has no employees, have the applicant submit a letter stating they have no employees.

ADVERTISING

- Getting the word out is the hardest.
- We used the city website, the newspaper, social media, and an email blast to business with less than 25 employees.
- We also put flyers out in the community and at extended stay hotels in the city limits.
