







 Rule of Thirds A photographic composition Principle that says an image should be broken down into thirds, both horizontally and vertically, so you have nine parts in total

Auto-It Does Everything For You

ISO-International Organization Of Standard (What?) The Sensitivity Of The Camera Sensor To Light. The Higher The Number, The More Sensitive To Light The Sensor Becomes. Keep In Mind, The Higher The Number, The More Grainy The Picture Can Be.

Some Terminology:

White Balance-How Your Camera Handles Different Types Of Light

Most Phones Will Have Some Basic Settings: Auto, Cloudy, Daylight, Fluorescent, Indoor. If You're Unsure, Just Play With It.

There's an old saying: Nothing ruins a great video like lousy audio.





- So, Here Are A Few Easy Tips To Capture Good Audio For Your Video
- Get Close To The Source
- Cut Down Distortion-Limit Background Noise As Much As Possible, Loud Volume IS GOING TO DISTORT. Put Your Phone in "Airplane Mode".
- If You Have The Ability To Edit The Video, You Can Use A Separate Phone To Capture The Audio, And Then Marry It To The Video.
- Use An External Microphone.
